ALICIA GILLESKIE SPEAKS AT CAPLAW NATIONAL TRAINING CONFERENCE

Raleigh (June 22, 2009) – Alicia Gilleskie, Smith Anderson associate, is speaking at the 2009 Community Action Program Legal Services, Inc. (CAPLAW) National Training Conference in Seattle, Washington on Wednesday, June 24. The conference attracts a nationwide audience, with over 500 attendees that include Community Action Agency (CAA) executives, attorneys and representatives from federal and state government agencies.

Ms. Gilleskie's presentation provides an overview of Privacy laws and standards that apply to the collection, use and maintenance of clients' and employees' personal information. The discussion includes an overview of Section 5 of the FTC Act, the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS), state data breach notification laws and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). Organizations will learn what restrictions apply to their use and disclosure of personal information, and what they should be doing to protection personal information.
