MATT RHOAD TO SERVE ON THE SECTION COUNCIL OF THE ZONING, PLANNING, AND LAND USE SECTION OF THE NCBA

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Raleigh, NC (April 15, 2011) – Matt Rhoad, a lawyer with Smith Anderson’s Land Use and Zoning and Commercial Real Estate practice groups, has been elected to serve a three year term on the Section Council of the Zoning, Planning, and Land Use Section of the North Carolina Bar Association.

Mr. Rhoad joined Smith Anderson in August, 2002, after completing a two-year clerkship with Justice (now Chief Justice) Sarah Parker of the North Carolina Supreme Court.
