### JACKSON MOORE SPEAKS ON GOVERNMENT CONTRACTING TO THE FORT BRAGG POST OF THE SOCIETY OF AMERICAN MILITARY ENGINEERS

**Raleigh, N.C.** – On November 21, 2013, [Jackson Moore](#), a partner at Smith Anderson, served as a panelist at the 2013 Scholarship Small Business Workshop hosted by the Fort Bragg Post of the Society of American Military Engineer's (SAME).
