Phil Cardinale, Intellectual property attorney at Smith Anderson, was recently honored with an “Outstanding Leadership” award from the American Bar Association Intellectual Property Law Section (ABA-IPL). The ABA-IPL advances the development and improvement of intellectual property laws and their fair and just administration.

The ABA is the largest voluntary professional association in the world, and the ABA-IPL, founded in 1894, is the world’s largest intellectual property organization and the oldest substantive section of the ABA.
