### JACKSON MOORE AND DAVID HAYDEN SPEAK AT THE NORTH CAROLINA BAR ASSOCIATION'S 2012 BUSINESS LAW INSTITUTE ON CONTRACTING WITH THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

**RALEIGH, N.C.** – Smith Anderson lawyers Jackson Moore and David Hayden presented a seminar on Contracting with the Federal Government at the North Carolina Bar Association's 2012 Business Law Institute held in Pinehurst, NC, on February 16-17, 2012.
